Students could soon commence medicine studies right after completing high school, with plans to accept enrolments for Queensland's first five-year undergraduate Doctor of Medicine program in 2027. The direct pathway to becoming a doctor has been streamlined and allows eligible students to graduate with less education-related debt, while addressing urgent healthcare workforce shortages. 
